Live wells must be empty.</p> <p><u>Place:</u> Milford State Park Marina</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 am or first safe light.</p> <p>First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Tournament Water \ Info</u></p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p> <p>Boundaries: None The tournament waters for this event shall be Milford Lake and shall include all creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted Off-limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live release areas established by the Tour Director will be Off-limits, that as well as any additional off-limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All Local, State & Federal/Canadian Regulations Apply.</p> <p><i>KS State Fishing License is required.</i></p>
<p align="center"><u>Fish Limits</u></p> <p>Fish size: 18 inches and over.</p> <p>Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of 5 fish per team per day. <p align="center"><u>Rules & Additional Information</u></p> <p align="center">Please read the NEW 2015 official NTC tournament rules carefully.</p> <p><u>Required Safety Equipment</u> It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throw able PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>KS state law requires that NO water may be transported away from the lake in a boat or container of any kind this INCLUDES bait wells. All drain plugs and water must be drained/removed before leaving the ramp area every day. By law, any live bait fish you have in your possession you MUST have a receipt of purchase with them from a retail bait supplier in the state of Kansas. Buy ONLY enough for each day as no water can be taken from the lake and transported back to hotels or anywhere, this includes bait wells.
