

Registration/Rules Meeting

Date: Wednesday, July 21, 2021

Registration Times:

MUST attend.

4:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. DO NOT WAIT Until 6:00pm and show up there are 219 teams! 6:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member

All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

Fish Limits

Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over. Culling is allowed.

Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making final run to check-in. Culling is allowed.

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.

Launch/Weigh-In

AuSable Harbor of Refuge 4440 .S U.S. 23, Oscoda, MI 48750

Take-off ceremonies begins at 6:45am

First boat leaves at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.

Weigh-in begins at 3:00 p.m. each day and is free and open to the public.

Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

Boundaries

Lake Huron, US waters only, as Canadian waters are currently closed to US residents.

No Locking.

The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Huron and all US rivers, bays, creeks and canals connecting to the abovementioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
